Airport transport by taxi	<p>If you do not know Belgrade, taking a taxi is the best option. The taxis are readily available at the airport. Please make sure to inquire for a taxi at the info desk/counter located inside the airport (payment is via voucher). The expected amount for taxi transport from the Airport to the event venue is RSD 3,000 in local currency, i.e. approx. EUR 25, i.e. approx. Visa Information	It is the traveler's responsibility to comply with immigration or customs requirements when entering/exiting the country. Refer to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website for visa requirements and instructions at: https://www.mfa.gov.rs/en/citizens/travel-serbia/visa-requirements
Health Insurance	Participants are responsible for their own health insurance during the visit.
Weather Conditions	Expected daily temperatures in Belgrade are between 22-24°C (highs) and 14-16°C (lows). For detailed weather information, please consult: https://www.accuweather.com/en/rs/belgrade/298198/may-weather/298198
Currency	The official currency in Serbia is dinar (RSD). The current rate is approx. 1 EUR = 117 RSD. For optimal rates it is better to use the exchange offices (which are clearly marked and can be found easily around the city) than to exchange the money in banks. The exchange rate will be the least reasonable at the airport.
Payment Method	You can expect to be able to pay with your credit or debit card in most places like hotels, malls, large stores, supermarkets, restaurants, and some bars. You should not expect to be able to pay with your credit or debit card for taxis (unless you use taxi apps) or at newsstands, on public transport (shuttles, buses, tram, metro), small cafes or bars.
Communication & Time zone	Access code for Serbia is +381. The hotel has free Wi-Fi. Time zone in Serbia is CET.
